You can earn £1000 per module taught with around 2.5 hours a week expected for 8 weeks.



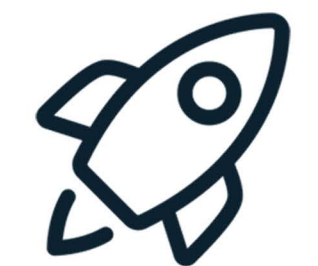

About the Role

The University-approved Postgraduate Medical Education Tutor role is a dynamic and globally accessible opportunity for experienced individuals in the medical field. This entirely online and part-time position allows for flexibility in working from anywhere worldwide. Tutors will play a key role in facilitating engaging discussions and activities within a 6-week module, fostering a collaborative learning environment.

This role involves posting pre-written case scenarios, providing feedback on student work, and contributing to the overall online learning experience. Whilst previous postgraduate tutoring experience would be desirable, a passion for teaching and mentoring the next generation of healthcare professionals is crucial for success in this role.

Tutors will receive £1000 per taught module as well as 15 hours of Continuing Professional Development (CPD), making this a unique and rewarding opportunity in the online education space.

- Collaborate with students to publish MSc work as a listed author
- Be awarded CPD points whilst flexibly working from any appropriate location

Time Commitment

Before the Module:

Before each set of modules begins, the Tutor Operations team will arrange the schedule and invite tutors with around 4 weeks' notice. Tutors can decline the invitation if the timing is not suitable and there is no set amount of groups that tutors must tutor each year.

If a tutor accepts the invitation, the Tutor Operations team will contact the tutor with a link to the module around 48 hours before the module begins. Tutors should spend time accessing the module and familiarising themselves with the content ahead of the students being enrolled.

During the Module:

Each Postgraduate Diploma module runs for 6 weeks, during this period, tutors are expected to log in for 30 minutes a day, 5 days a week (with an approximate commitment of 2.5 hours per week). Tutors can work from anywhere in the world and can log in and interact with students around their day-to-day lives. During the module, the tutor's responsibility is to:

- Post pre-written content to students in the form of clinical case scenarios. Tutors should make their first post by 9 AM UK time (although this can be posted over the weekend to accommodate differing schedules) and their final scenario by 3 PM UK time on Thursday afternoon. Typically, tutors will post scenarios on a Monday, Wednesday and Thursday. All content is pre-written and provided to tutors including further discussion prompts, model answers, and reference lists.
- Monitor, evaluate, and provide constructive feedback, extending and challenging student learning in the forum in response to their replies to the case scenarios. The tutor's responses should extend the students' discussions encouraging them to continue extending their knowledge.
- Provide a weekly comment of feedback on the student's Reflective Journal, a private log for student reflection.

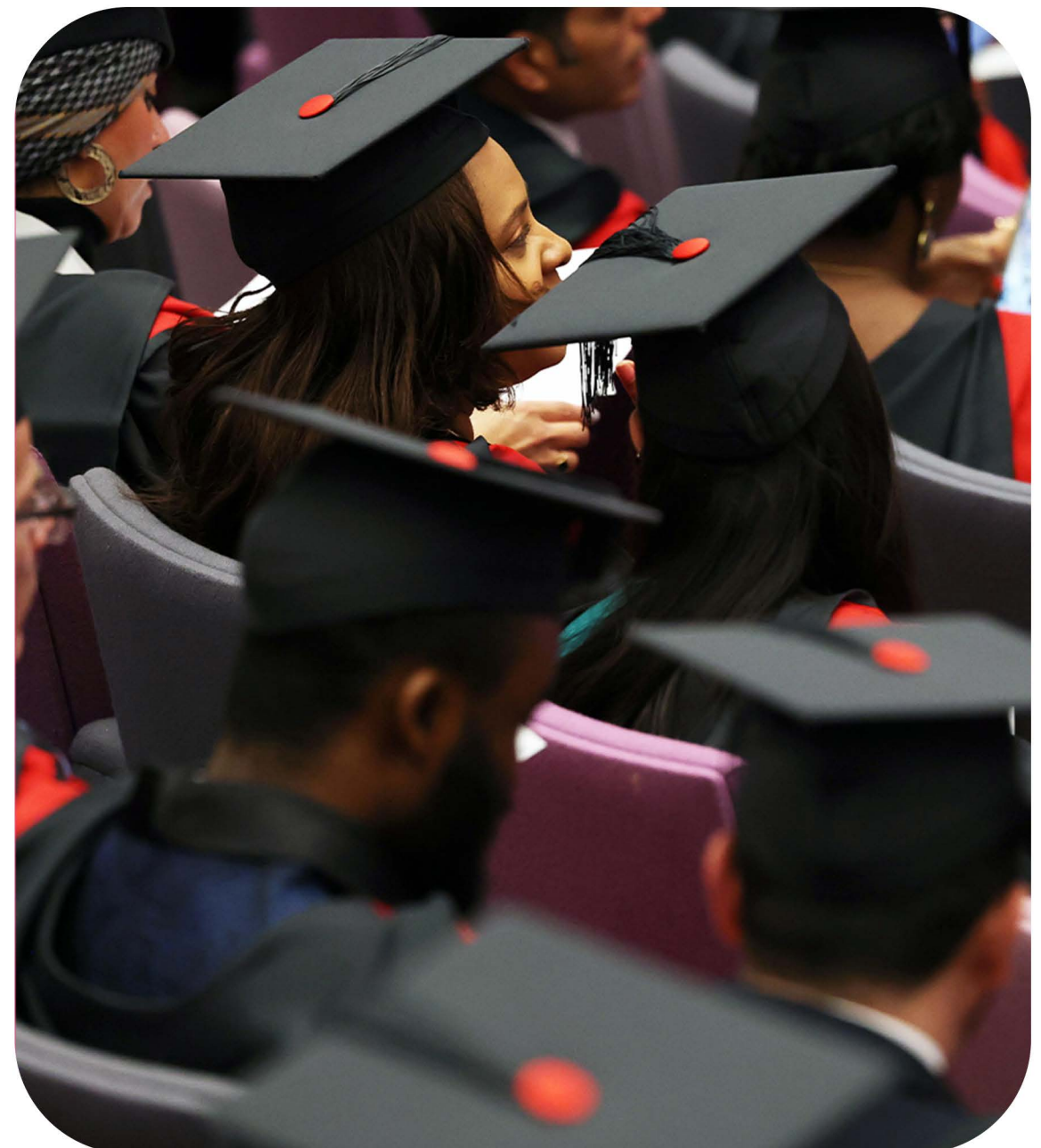
After the Module:

As the module concludes, tutors will then enter the marking period. The time commitment during the marking period can vary depending on group size however, we anticipate that the marking and double marking tasks should take around 4 hours to complete; Tutors should:

- Grade and offer feedback to students within their assigned group at the conclusion of each 6-week module, in line with the partner university's marking guidance, within a deadline provided by the Tutor Operations team .
- Participate in the double-marking process to ensure consistency and quality assurance in line with partner university guidelines.

Additional Responsibilities:

- Offer academic and pastoral support to students throughout the module, raising any concerns with the Tutor Operations team at Learna.
- Proficient use of our online learning platform (training will be provided to you). Ensure that personal subject knowledge is current and to be familiar with the suggested reading of the course.
- Engage with various Learna teams to contribute to the overall success of the course and enhance the student experience; in particular, engaging with the Tutor Operations team during the module.
- Encourage high-achieving students whilst motivating struggling candidates to give them excellent learning experiences, and maximise student attainment.
- Motivate all students to participate, thereby maximising their engagement and minimising attrition.



Requisite Skills and Experience:

- Proven experience in tutoring at a postgraduate level.
- Hold an MSc or an equivalent postgraduate qualification in the relevant field.
- Demonstrated expertise in the respective field of specialisation.
- Passionate about imparting knowledge to the next generation.
- Proficiency in the use of IT systems.
- The ability to communicate effectively with a varied audience on an online platform.
- Maintain a professional tone in English and support students with their formal academic writing.
