Modules

Tutors will :

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Expectations for Tutor Engagement on a Module:

Time commitment guide

- 30 minutes each weekday
- 2-3 hours on a weekend

Module commitment

Tutors will:

- Keep up to date with recent guidelines and current subject knowledge and contribute to the maintenance and development of the module.
- Work with the Course Director to develop the quality of the module.
- Monitor student work, for good practice (e.g. critical analysis) poor practice (e.g. cutting and pasting) and academic infringements (e.g. plagiarism) using Turn-it-In to assist where necessary.

PGDip and MSc module 1

Tutors will:

- Contribute to the portfolio weekly
- Guide the case discussion as often as possible at least every other day
- Monitor group activity every few days
- Mark group work within 5 working days after module has been completed
- Double mark two students from one other group
- Write 2/3 new questions (BoF and Long Stem) for each module they are tutoring on and submit to the Course Director prior to being added to the question bank.

MSc Project

Tutors will:



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- Contribute to the portfolio weekly
- `Mark professional projects within 20 working days
